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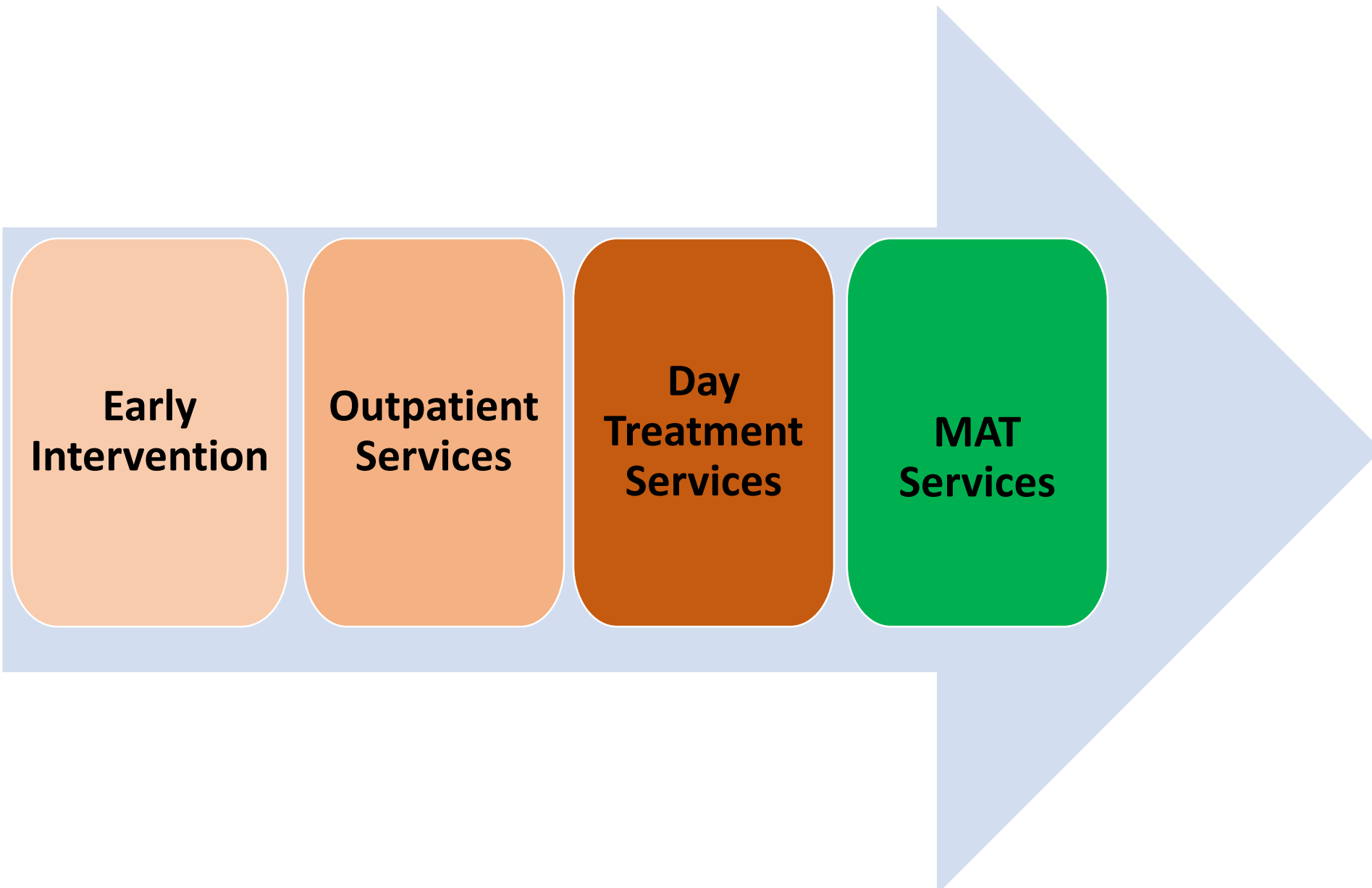


- Established 1972, Yolo County, Federally Qualified Health Center

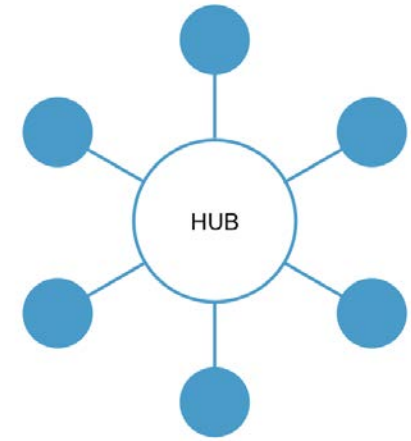

Medication Assisted Treatment at CommuniCare Hub and Spoke Expansion started September 2017

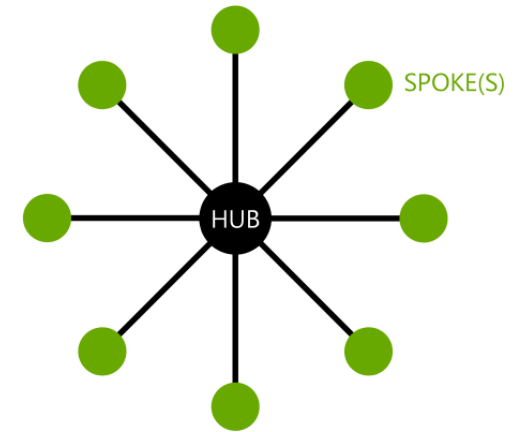
- Adaptation of the successful model used in Vermont.
- The primary goals are to prevent overdose and treat Opioid Use Disorder as a chronic disease.
- To improve, expand, and increase access to MAT services throughout the state.
- Increase the total number of physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners prescribing buprenorphine, thereby increasing the availability of MAT for patients with OUDs.
- All Hub and Spokes must obtain or be currently enrolled in Drug Medi-Cal or Fee-for-Service Medi-Cal.

What is a Hub?



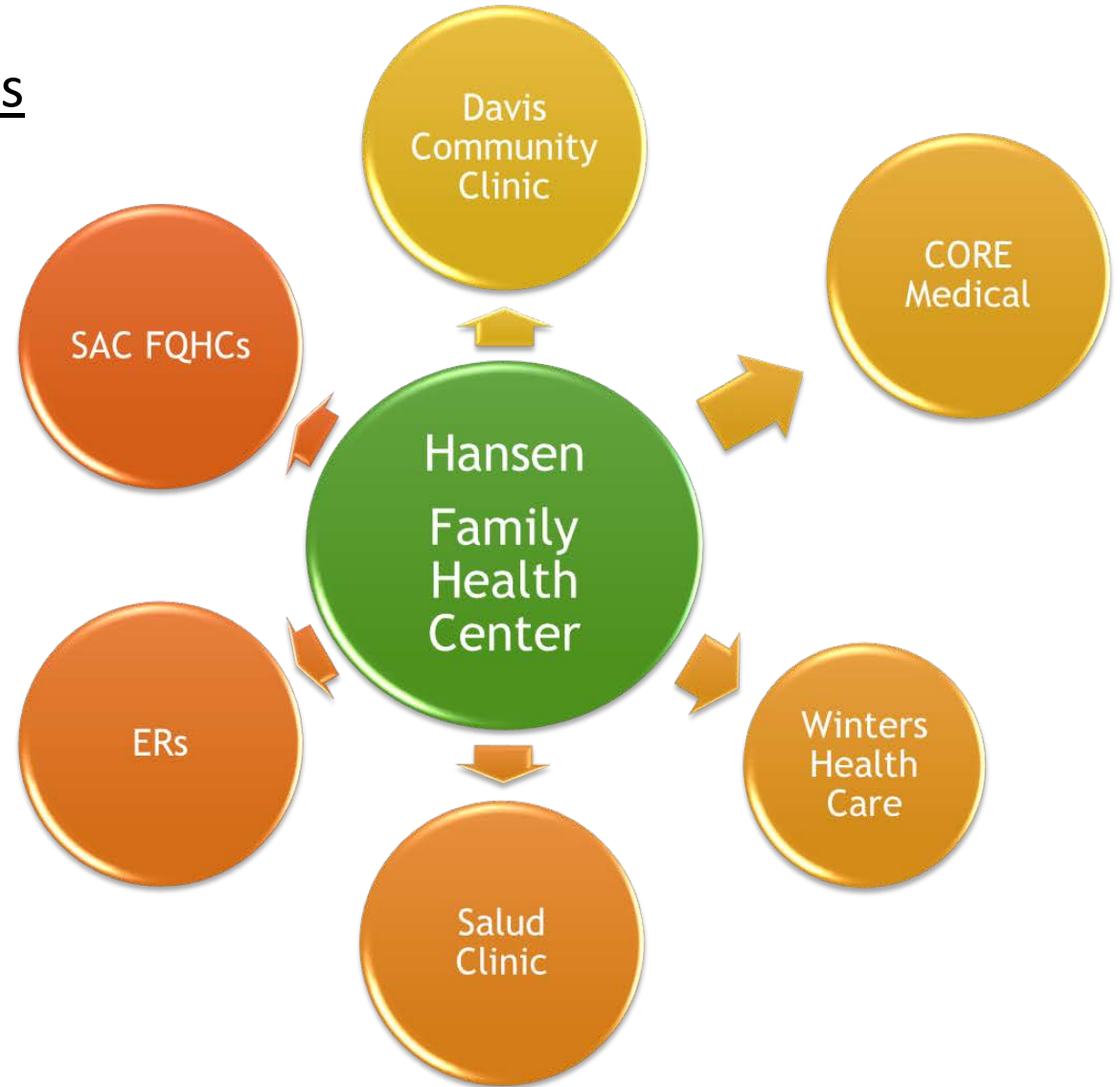
- Narcotic treatment programs (NTPs)
- Hubs shall serve as a regional resource and offer complex care
- Patients will be able to move between the Hub and Spokes based on clinical severity.
- Hubs are responsible for the following:
 - 1. Outreach; 2. Treatment Services; 3. Data Collection and Performance Measures; 4. Reports; 5. Evaluation; 6. Training; 7. Invoices; and 8. Subcontracting (with spokes).

What is a Spoke?



- A federally waived prescriber who prescribes and/or administers buprenorphine
- Spokes provide ongoing care for patients with milder disorders, managing both induction and maintenance, and have access to a dedicated MAT team.
- Patients will be able to move between the Hub and Spokes based on clinical severity.

- In partnership with CORE Medical Clinics
- Expanded services
- Develop broader safety net
- Expand number of prescribers
- Funding for uninsured
- Increase access for community



SUD Treatment in an FQHC



- SUD screening/brief intervention and referral to treatment all under one roof in a less stigmatized setting.
 - ✓ Outpatient SUD services
 - ✓ Youth SUD Services
 - ✓ Medication Assisted Treatment (Vivitrol/Suboxone)
 - ✓ Perinatal Substance Use Services
