Accomplishments from Spring 2023

- Over 400 students and staff trained on opioid overdose prevention and Narcan use
- Over 60 units of Narcan provided to AED boxes at multiple campus buildings for emergency use

Efforts for upcoming AY 2023-2024

- Continued collaboration with campus partners to train students and staff
- Monthly in-person Narcan trainings for all campus members
- Promotion of new asynchronous training option
